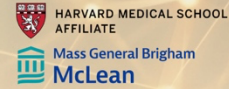

Call for Poster Proposals

The **Institute for Technology in Psychiatry (ITP) at McLean Hospital** is pleased to launch the call for poster submissions for the **10th Annual 2026 Technology in Psychiatry Summit**.

- **When:** December 10–11, 2026
- **Where:** Joseph B. Martin Conference Center, Boston, MA

Poster Session Details:

The poster session will be held **in-person on the first day of the summit (December 10)**.

- **Attendance & Registration:** The lead author on each poster must register and attend the summit in-person. A discounted student rate is available for those who qualify.
- **Virtual Options:** We are currently evaluating whether a virtual poster option will be offered to allow digital viewing by attendees throughout the summit. We will provide updates to accepted presenters as more information becomes available. However, there will be no VIRTUAL-ONLY option. All presenters must be available in-person.

Submission Requirements:

Your poster submission must include the following:

- **Abstract Title**
- **Abstract**
- **Authors / Co-Authors**

Important Reminders for Presenters:

- **Originality:** All submitted work must be your own or that of your co-authors.
- **Registration:** Accepted presenters are required to register for the summit to secure their spot.
- **Setup:** Authors must bring their printed posters to the Joseph B. Martin Conference Center on the morning of **December 10th** to hang them up.
- **Presentation:** Presenters are expected to be at their posters during the evening session on **December 10th** (following the day's main agenda) to discuss their work with attendees.
- **Takedown:** Presenters must take down and take home their posters at the end of the evening session on the 10th. Posters remaining on the 11th will be discarded unless otherwise discussed.
- **Multiple Submissions:** Multiple submissions are permitted, though we highly recommend consolidating your findings into a single submission where possible.

- AI and Society
- Digital Health Applications
- Human-Computer Interface
- Pervasive Sensing
- Phenotyping at Scale
